## Immeasurably More By Faith (Week 1)

### Group Focus:

God has **immeasurably more** for every person – but each of us must decide how we respond on our spiritual journey. Wherever we are, God is inviting us to take a **next step by faith**.

### Welcome, Connection & Check-in:

Take a moment to check in as a group.

- How has your past week been?
- What stood out to you most from Sunday's message?

(Keep this relational and brief.)

### Scripture:

Ephesians 3:20–21

Optional reference: John 10:10

### Big Idea:

The Bible makes it clear that life with Jesus is never stagnant – there is always **more**. Paul reminds us that God is able to do *immeasurably more* than we can ask or imagine.

Our faith journey can be pictured like a staircase, and at every stage we face a choice:

- **Step back** when life gets hard
- **Stay put** when comfort feels safe
- **Step up** by faith into what God is inviting us into

God's promise hasn't changed – but our response matters. The question is not *does God have more?* The question is: **Will we step into it?**

### Discussion Questions:

#### 1. **Where are you right now?**

Looking at the three options – *stepping back*, *staying put*, or *stepping up* – which one best describes your current spiritual posture, and why?

#### 2. **Faith in action**

Stepping up is often uncomfortable and requires trust. What might be one simple **next step of faith** God could be inviting you into right now?

#### 3. **Immeasurably more**

The message reminded us that God's "more" isn't just in one area, but every area. Where do you most need to trust God for *immeasurably more* in this season?

### Prayer & Response:

Take time to pray together.

- Ask the Holy Spirit: **"What is my next step?"**
- Pray for courage to not step back or stay stuck, but to step up by faith.
- Encourage one another to walk this journey together – not alone.

### Group Practice (Optional):

Each person names one intentional next step they will pray about or take this week – no pressure, just obedience.
